


A Message From Pastor Tom

Committee Reports:

Youth & Education: The Sunday school children are practicing on Sunday mornings for their Christmas program, *The Manger Tales* on Sunday, December 15th. Nine children are participating in the Christmas program.

Property and Finance: The first budget meeting for 2025 will be on Wednesday, November 13^{th} . Additional budget items discussed at the meeting -1) Beloit support increased to \$1000, 2) New road signs for WBLC at entrance to Williams Bay will be purchased next year, proposed budget \$2000. Budget will be delivered to congregation December 11.

Worship: The church choir is rehearsing at 11:00 AM on Sunday mornings. The choir will be preforming, *Bethlehem Lullaby* at the Christmas Eve service on Tuesday, December 24th at 5:00 PM. Marianne Peterson has decided not to play for the 8:00 service but will continue to be a substitute for the 8:00 service. Susan Gali and Chris Groth have offered to help with the 8:00 service. We need one more musician for the 8:00 service.

Stewardship: "Celebrate the Past, Envision the Future," was our stewardship theme this year. Members are invited to fill out a pledge form and a time and talents form for 2025. The last highway pick-up of the year was held on Saturday, October 19th with three members participating. New Williams Bay Lutheran Pick-Up County Highway signs replaced the old signs on our portion of the highway on Highway 14 West out of Walworth. Stu is organizing Salvation Army Bell-Ringing for this Saturday, November 23rd at Daniels in Walworth.

Outreach/Evangelism: There was a very large turnout this year for the community CROP Hunger Walk in Williams Bay with 153 walkers and a donation of \$23,625. Sixteen members participated in the walk and our members gave \$2,185 to this hunger ministry. We received a record 800 + pounds of food for Food Pantry Sunday! The food donations were given to the Chapel on the Hill Food Pantry. Mark Reno planned this year's God's Work. Our Hands community service work. Members were invited to help with packing food at the Walworth County Food Pantry in Elkhorn on Tuesday, November 19th.
