Ministry Highlights:

Four churches participated in the community service: United Church of Christ of Williams Bay, Chapel on the Hill, First Congregational United Church of Christ of Lake Geneva, and our congregation. I was very happy to see that eight members from our church attended the Thanksgiving service. Our members found the service to be very special and meaningful. The next ecumenical event will be the Good Friday Cross Walk in Williams Bay followed by the Ecumenical Easter Sunrise Service and breakfast. This year it is our turn to host the early morning Easter service and breakfast.
