## A Message From Pastor Tom




**Our Partnership with the Williams Bay Scouts**






Ministry Highlight:

- Ann Garey, activity director at Sherwood Lodge in Williams Bay, recently contacted me to
  offer worship services for the senior residents. I led my first worship service at Sherwood on
  Tuesday, February 4<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 AM in the chapel at Sherwood Lodge. I will now be on their
  monthly calendar to offer worship services the first Tuesday of every month at 10:30 AM. This
  is a great outreach opportunity for me and I am happy to offer these services for community
  members in Williams Bay.
- For the last three years I have served as the ecumenical community organizer of Williams Bay. In the last year our clergy group has grown to eleven pastors! We currently meet on Thursday mornings at Boxed & Burlap in Williams Bay for conversation and to plan our next ecumenical events.
